Over the past six years, the DFG research unit *Cosmic Sense* has been advancing the measurement of soil moisture (and snow) from field to catchment scale, with a primary focus on Cosmic Ray Neutron Sensing, alongside complementary methods such as numerical modeling, remote sensing, and other *in-situ* measurements.
