Launch of CONNECT by YERUN

The University of Potsdam is a member of the <u>Young European Research Universities Network</u> (YERUN), which comprises 23 European universities in total. On **28 June 2024**, YERUN will launch **CONNECT by YERUN**, an online platform to connect researchers from the member universities, identify EU funding opportunities for research projects and collaborate on research activities (e.g., finding a host for mobility awards or engaging peers for pre-reviewing applications). CONNECT by YERUN has been developed by the University of Southern Denmark (SDU), which is also a member of the network.

The link to the platform is: https://connect-by-yerun.eu/. Researchers log in with their ORCID account. If you do not have one, you can create it on the ORCID website. Important! You must enter your University of Potsdam email address in your ORCID profile and this address must be visible to everyone in order that CONNECT by YERUN can find your profile.

Do not miss the **launch webinar on 28 June, 10-12 CET!** In the webinar, SDU will introduce CONNECT by YERUN and give instructions on how to use it. During the webinar, they will present the platform, guide participants through the navigation, and address general

questions of common interest. Personal inquiries or specific issues with accessibility to individual profiles will be handled via email to ensure personalised support. **Target audience:** all researchers interested in getting to know the platform. If you are a staff member of the University of Potsdam, you can register to the webinar via <u>this link</u>. You will then receive a confirmation email with the link to connect.

MSCA provides €10 million to support displaced researchers from Ukraine



The European Commission will provide a €10 million top-up for fellowships for researchers displaced from Ukraine. This additional funding will be allocated to the MSCA4Ukraine initiative and will allow around 50 more new fellows, including doctoral and postdoctoral researchers, to continue their research projects at host organisations in the EU and Horizon Europe associated countries.

The next call is expected to open in June and close in early September. Interested researchers and host organisations will be able to apply via the <u>MSCA4Ukraine website</u>.

New strategic plan for Horizon Europe



The second Horizon Europe strategic plan will steer research and innovation funding within and beyond Europe, to tackle the key global challenges such as climate change, pollution and loss of biodiversity, the digital transition and an ageing population. From fundamental research to breakthrough innovation and deployment of innovative solutions, the strategic plan directs investments into the green and digital transition, building a more resilient, competitive, democratic and inclusive Europe.

The Horizon Europe strategic plan for 2025-2027 builds on an extensive analysis conducted by the Commission services,

including a gap analysis on the missing topics and potential gaps within the intervention areas provided in the Horizon Europe legal basis. You can download the new strategic plan and find more information on the <u>website of the European Commission</u>.

University of Potsdam - EU Research Funding



Annotated Model Grant Agreement published

On 8 May, the European Commission published a **first complete version of the Annotated Grant Agreement (AGA) for EU Funding Programmes 2021-2027** on the <u>EU Funding & Tenders Portal</u>. As a corporate model, the Grant Agreement for the current funding period shall harmonize the funding rules for Horizon Europe, ERASMUS+ as well as other EU programmes.

The AGA complements the Model Grant Agreement (MGA), which is the template for the contract between the European Commission (or its executive agencies) and the beneficiaries of grants in EU programmes. The AGA contains explanations and examples for the interpretation and implementation of the Grant Agreement. It provides **guidance on all articles of the MGA** – including personnel costs calculation, reporting, audits, termination of the grant, access to research infrastructures and the management of lump sum grants.

EU guidelines on the responsible use of generative AI



The European Commission, along with the European Research Area countries and stakeholders, has published a set of guidelines to aid the European research community in the ethical application of generative artificial intelligence (AI). These guidelines offer recommendations directed at researchers, research organizations, and research funding organizations.

Association of Third Countries to Horizon Europe

Republic of Korea:

Korea will join the group of countries associated with Horizon Europe. The Association Agreement, negotiated by Commissioner Iliana Ivanova and Korean Minister Lee Jong Ho, is expected to be signed in late 2024, enabling Korea's participation in Horizon Europe from 2025 under Pillar II (Global Challenges & European Industrial Competitiveness). Switzerland:

In spring 2024 the European Commission and Switzerland started formal negotiations on Switzerland's participation in EU programmes like Horizon Europe. The launch of these negotiations enables Swiss entities to apply and be evaluated as prospective beneficiaries in the European Research Council calls of its 2024 work programme opening as of now. Swiss applicants will be treated as if Switzerland is an associated country throughout the process, from admissibility and eligibility to evaluation, up until the preparation of grant agreements. However, grant agreements can only be signed if the association applies at that time.

Next Erasmus+ calls

The next round of Erasmus+ calls (Cooperation Partnerships, Capacity Building Projects, Erasmus Mundus Action, Jean Monnet Actions, etc.) is expected to be launched in autumn 2024. The calls will be published in the Funding & Tender Opportunities Portal (FTOP). The Erasmus+ Programme Guide provides the details of each action (aims, eligible organisations, budget, duration, etc.).

Funding of travel costs for the preparation of Erasmus+ projects through the NA DAAD

New Erasmus+ project at the University of Potsdam

The University of Potsdam participates in the Erasmus+ Cooperation Partnership "Digital Transformation of Language Teacher Education with Data-Informed Evidence − DigitTE". The DigitTE project started in March 2024 and is funded by the Erasmus+ programme with €250.000 for a period of two years. DigitTE aims to develop a video-based, digitally enhanced, data-supported and evidence-based environment for the training of language teachers. The Cooperation Partnerships comprises five universities from four different countries: TED University and Bartin University from Turkey, Linköping University from Sweden, International University of Catalonia from Spain and University of Potsdam from Germany. Dr. Taiane Malabarba (Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Institute for English and American Studies) leads the project at the University of Potsdam.
