Interim evaluation of Horizon Europe (Heitor Report) published



The report on the interim evaluation of Horizon Europe entitled "[Align, Act, Accelerate](#)" emphasizes that immediate action is essential if Europe is to maintain its outstanding position in research and innovation. The group of experts led by Manuel Heitor, former Portuguese Secretary of State at the European Commission, who drafted the report, urgently **calls for significant changes to the next research framework program**. For example, experimental units should be set up as quickly as possible to test the success of new funding measures and evaluation processes, among other things, before the next research framework program (FP10) starts. The report also makes **further recommendations, such as increasing the budget to 220 billion euros, setting up a Societal Challenges Council** to address key societal challenges, and strengthening excellence and competitiveness.

Work Programmes for Horizon Europe Pillar II expected in April

The work programmes for the clusters in Pillar II, including the call topics for 2025, are expected to be published by the European Commission at the end of April 2025. Draft versions have been published on the Science|Business Network [website](#). Please note that the contents are preliminary and subject to change.

Association of Third Countries to Horizon Europe

Switzerland

Negotiations on Switzerland's association to **all three pillars of Horizon Europe and the Euratom research and training programme** have concluded. Switzerland is expected to sign the agreement on its participation in the Union's programmes in 2025. Once signed, Switzerland will become an Associated Country in both programmes with retroactive effect from 1 January 2025. Swiss applicants will be granted transitional arrangements pending the agreement's signature. Updates on Switzerland's association will be published on the dedicated [EC website](#).

Republic of Korea

On 1 January 2025, the Republic of Korea joined Horizon Europe, opening up new opportunities for researchers and unlocking potential for cooperation. The European Union thus welcomes researchers and organisations from the Republic of Korea to participate in **Pillar II of the Horizon Europe programme** from the Work Programme 2025 onwards. The Association Agreement is expected to be signed in 2025. Updates will be published on the dedicated [EC website](#).

Using CONNECT by YERUN for international research collaboration

Since 2022, the University of Potsdam is part of the YERUN network of young European research universities. This network offers researchers various funding opportunities (such as the YERUN Research Mobility Awards or the Open Science Awards) as well as networking opportunities.

New EU projects at the University of Potsdam

In 2023, the **European Research Council (ERC)** announced 102 **Proof of Concept** grants to ERC grantees to bridge the gap between the results of their pioneering research and the early phases of its commercialization.

One of them is **Prof. Dr. Jan Härter (Professor of Climate Physics)** with his project **DakE (High-resolution automatic weather monitoring system east of Dakar)**.

The project started in July 2024 and deals with a novel methodology for flood and storm early warning, implemented in Senegal.

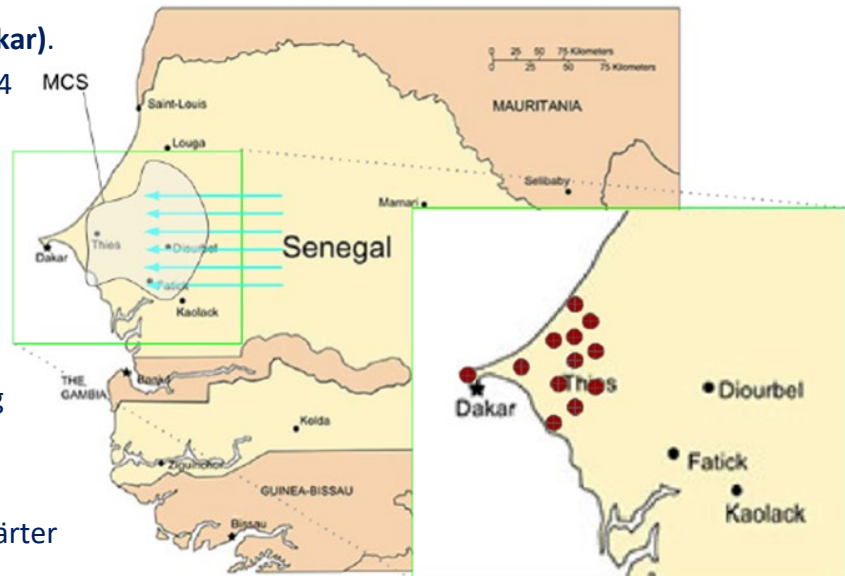

We welcome a **new MSCA Postdoctoral Fellow**, Dr. Gaspar Litholdo, who started at UP on 1 January 2025! His project, MemoryRNA, investigates how plants react to rising temperatures as a result of climate change and what role do genes play in a plant's response to heat stress.

Furthermore, **two ERC projects will start at UP in spring 2025**. One of them is **COMSCAL**, a Horizon Europe ERC Starting Grant in geometry, which will be transferred from the University of Münster to UP when the PI, Prof. Dr. Rudolph Zeidler, takes up his professorship at the Institute of Mathematics on 1 April 2025.

The other one is **CasualEarth**, a Horizon 2020 ERC Starting Grant transferred from the TU Dresden to UP on 1 March 2025. Jakob Runge, Professor for Artificial Intelligence in Sciences, is PI of this interdisciplinary project that aims to improve our understanding of the interdependencies between major drivers (modes) of climate variability by developing novel statistical causal inference methods for both observations and model data.
