

Teaching Across Borders:

A 5-Day International Exchange for Future Educators

Day 1)

- **Icebreaking activities** (World map connections; Speed Networking; Two Truths and a Lie: Educator Edition; Group collage creation etc.)
- Cultural Exchange Presentation: Each group of students prepares a short presentation about the educational system, teaching methods, and classroom culture in their home country; the activity aims to get insights into different educational practices.
- Discussion about national teachers' standards

Day 2)

- Collaborative Lesson Planning: mixed-nationality groups. Each group collaborates to design a lesson plan incorporating teaching methods from each member's home country; aim of the activity: Sharing of best practices and developing skills in creating adaptable and inclusive lesson plans.
- Global Education Policy Debate: Discussion on global education challenges such as addressing diversity in the classroom. The activity aims to think critically about solutions of current education challenges and inspire each other.

Day 3)

- School Visit Day: guided tour; observation and Interaction
- Post-visit reflection and discussion, with comparative analysis

Day 4)

- Presentation of projects from the Day 2
- Visit of HUME Lab, Experimental Humanities Laboratory

Day 5)

- Expert Talk and Workshop: Talk and workshop on a specific educational theme (either about processes of teachers' reconceptualization of students or equal participation in classroom discourse).
